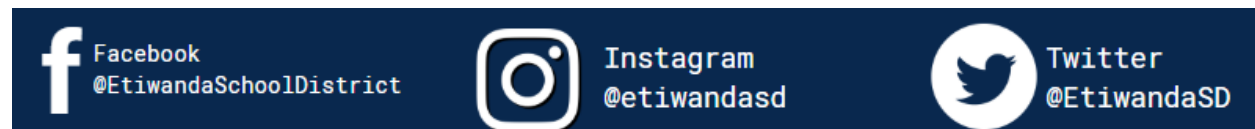
We hope our families find these updates helpful. We look forward to our continued partnership as we forge ahead in overcoming the challenges our community is currently facing.

2020-21 School Year TK/K Enrollment - Online enrollment for TK and Kindergarten begins Wednesday, April 1. Please visit our website at www.etiwanda.org and select the Enrollment tab at the right to begin the process. As an update to the online enrollment process as a result of school closures, families will need to upload/attach four documents into the system:

1. A certified birth certificate
2. Immunization record
3. Proof of residency for district schools
4. A second proof of residency

Please note: Uploading documents is a new requirement. In past years, families have been asked to bring these documents to the school to complete the registration process. Registration is not complete until all documents have been submitted and verified by the school office.
