CONDITIONAL ADMISSIONS: Children lacking one or more required vaccine doses but not currently due for a dose may be admitted on condition they receive remaining doses when due, according to the schedule below. If the maximum time interval has passed, the child must be excluded until the next immunization is obtained.

VACCINE	TIME INTERVALS BETWEEN DOSES
Polio	2 nd dose: 6 - 10 weeks after 1 st dose 3 rd dose: 6 weeks to 12 months after 2 nd dose
DTP, Tdap, and Td Under 7 years (DTP, DTaP)	2 nd dose: 4 - 8 weeks after 1 st dose 3 rd dose: 4 - 8 weeks after 2 nd dose 4 th dose: 6 - 12 months after 3 rd dose
Age 7 years and older (Tdap)*	2 nd dose: 4 - 8 weeks after 1 st dose 3 rd dose: 6 - 12 months after 2 nd dose
MMR	2 nd dose: 1 - 3 months after 1 st dose
Hepatitis B	2 nd dose: 1 - 2 months after 1 st dose 3 rd dose: 2 - 6 months after 2 nd dose, and at least 4 months after 1 st dose
Varicella	***2 nd dose: 4 weeks – 3 months. Required FOR AGE 13 YEARS AND OLDER if student has not previously attended a California school. 2 nd dose due at least 4 weeks from 1 st dose.

Note: DTP, Tdap, DTaP, Td doses received previously count toward meeting the 3-dose tetanus-diphtheria immunization requirement for this age group but one pertussis containing vaccine **MUST** be received on or after the 7th birthday (no grace period).

****Note:** MMR and Varicella should be given on the **same** day. If both immunizations were given on separate days but with less than 28 days between them, the second immunization is recommended to be re-administered.

* Grace period of 1-4 days allowed. (No grace period for Tdap requirement after 7th birthday.)
